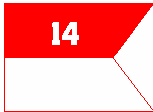




14th CAVALRY ASSOCIATION

WELCOME: The association exists to reflect the history of a proud Regiment and to promote communication among those who have been privileged to serve in its squadrons and battalions. We honor those who served with the:

- **14th Cavalry Regiment (Horse)** 1901 to 1943: Campaigns in the Philippines and on the Mexican Border.
- **14th Cavalry Group** in Europe during World War II: The Losheim Gap & bridgehead at Remagen.
- **14th Constabulary Regiment:** The occupation of Germany following World War II.
- **14th Armored Cavalry Regiment:** On the front line of NATO's most critical sector during the Cold War.
- **14th Cavalry RSTA Squadrons** (Reconnaissance, Surveillance and Target Acquisition) Sept. 2000 to date: At the forefront of the transition to a rapidly-deployable force. Upholding the tradition with their service in Iraq.

PURPOSE: The 14th Cavalry Association is a fraternal, not-for-profit organization for veterans who served in all related units since the Regiment's inception in 1901; current members of the active duty units, and supporters of those units.
