What We Do

- 📌 We provide financial support to Active Duty Troopers to help them offset the cost of attending squadron activities.
- 📌 We present awards to the Trooper of the Year and the NCO of the Year of each squadron.
- 📌 We provide funds to squadrons annually for esprit and unit-building events, family-oriented functions and morale and welfare activities. In the past 10 years the Association has given nearly \$16,000 to Troopers and squadrons.
- 📌 We support Family Readiness Groups and activities sponsored by Spouses of the Regiment.
- 📌 We visit wounded Troopers in hospitals and long-term care facilities, and present them Association mementos.
- 📌 We attend funerals and memorials for our fallen Troopers, and present an inscribed saber and a set of gold spurs to their immediate family.
- 📌 We hold annual reunions in cities and at military bases across the nation that feature comradeship and “war stories” about the “old” and “new” Cav at Stable Call, in the Watering Hole and at the Regimental Banquet, and our Ceremony to the Fallen in honor of the service and sacrifice of 14th Cav Troopers.
- 📌 We offer Veteran and Active Duty Troopers opportunities to be Advisers to our committees and Advisory Board.
- 📌 We operate the Regimental Supply Room, the place to buy 14th Cav belt buckles, shirts, campaign hats, spurs and many other items. All profits support Troopers, squadrons and veterans.
- 📌 We provide connections by our four-color newsletter, CHARGE!, and our Facebook and Website.
- 📌 We celebrate the proud history of our Regiment and keep the traditions and spirit de corps of the Cavalry alive.

Who We Are

- 📌 We are nearly 450 Active Duty and veteran Troopers of all ranks who now serve with or who once served with a unit of the 14th Cavalry and the 14th Armored Cavalry, whether assigned or attached.
- 📌 And we are spouses, widows or widowers of 14th Cav Troopers.
- 📌 Most Troopers served in Iraq, Afghanistan, or in Germany during the Cold War. Many served in Vietnam, Korea and World War II. Many are on Active Duty. The length of service of the veteran Troopers spans two to 30-plus years.
- 📌 One is a Medal of Honor recipient. All are heroes.
- 📌 Rank is irrelevant in the Association —all are brothers- and sisters-in-arms.

What’s the Cost?

Joining doesn’t cost much. A few beers for a one-year membership or a couple tanks of gas for a five-year term.

📌 Joining for Life is the best deal. It’s equivalent to 14 one-year dues or 50-60 years’ FREE membership (based on joining at age 25 and today’s average life span of 76 for men and about 10 more years for women)
